

DRESS REGULATIONS



Dee Why RSL requires members, guests and visitors to be suitably attired. Dress is to be clean, neat and tidy at all times and the standard of dress remains at the Duty Managers' discretion.

Management reserves the right to refuse entry, or ask a patron to leave, if they are not suitably attired.

UNACCEPTABLE at all times

- Swimwear, leotards or lycra bike shorts
- Untidy, ripped or dirty attire
- Obscene or offensive language on clothing
- Tank tops, singlets (*men*), midriffs or see-through clothing
- Bare feet
- Hats (*ladies are permitted to wear non-peaked hats*)

UNACCEPTABLE after 8:00pm

- Thongs (*ladies' dress sandals are permitted*)
- Work boots/overalls
