

## Dee Why RSL awards ten local students with \$20,000 in scholarships

Once again, the Dee Why RSL School Scholarship Program has delivered a total of \$20,000 in scholarships to assist students in achieving their utmost potential whilst completing the Higher School Certificate.

The volume and quality of this year's applications were incredibly high, making it extremely difficult for the Dee Why RSL Board Panel, all retired school teachers, to award only 10 students. Students were given the opportunity to be assessed on their excellent academic performance and/or financial need, with this selection remaining confidential.

On Tuesday 3 December 2019, the Dee Why RSL Board and Executive Management team hosted a function to present each student with a \$2,000 cheque, certificate for their portfolio, and to take the opportunity to congratulate the students in person. 


